Guest Services Assistant **(Evenings/Saturdays) (Temporary- Fall 2026)**

Jordan Valley Water Conservancy District is seeking individuals to assist with guest services and garden maintenance at Conservation Garden Park during evenings and weekends.

Job Summary: Great opportunity for those interested in communicating about horticulture, landscaping, water conservation, and environmental science. Responsibilities include:

- Providing guest services at the Education Center (in-person, online, phone)
- Assisting with room set-up and clean-up for classes, events, and related activities
- Answering questions on plants, landscaping, and water conservation
- Assisting with garden care: weeding, pruning, watering, tending flowerpots and greenhouse
- Coordinating tours, rentals, and photography sessions

Internship: Job can be used as an internship based upon college/university approval.



Job Requirements: Experience or education in horticulture, landscaping, or guest services is preferred, but not required. Must have strong customer service skills and be available to work on weeknights and Saturdays. Must be comfortable interacting with the public to promote awareness of and interest in waterwise landscaping. Requires excellent communication to help the public and collaborate with team members. Must be self-motivated and able to transition between indoor and outdoor duties as assigned.

Wage: \$17-\$20 per hour

Hours: Part Time (15-30 hours/week) depending on availability from August through October. Required to work evenings, Saturdays, and some holidays.

Annual Hours Cap: 1100 Hours
